How it Functions?

Let's learn how "Design Sprint" works.

"We start with requirement analysis and feature define. Then continue with ideation, wire framing and break down into design tasks. Each sprint runs for five days and the end goal is to come up with a final prototype."

When you Need?

Scenarios of conducting Design Sprint.

- New Product Development: When launching a new product or service and you need to quickly validate ideas before investing in full development.
- Feature Enhancement: When adding significant new features to an existing product and wanting to ensure they meet user needs.
- Solving Complex Problems: When facing a complex problem or business challenge that requires innovative solutions and rapid iteration.
- Revamping UX/UI: When redesigning the user experience or interface of an existing product to improve usability and satisfaction.
- Exploring New Markets: When exploring new market opportunities or entering a new market segment to understand potential user needs and preferences.

Understand & Define

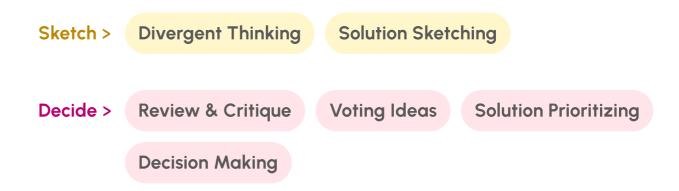
Gather insights, set a long-term goal, and map the challenge together with a cup of coffee.

Which ensure the goal is Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Time-bound to provide clear direction.



Sketch & Decide

In the "Sketch & Decide" phases of a design sprint, the team focuses on generating ideas, visualizing potential solutions, and making decisions on which ideas to pursue further.





DAY 3, 4 & 5

Prototype & Validate

The team creates a realistic prototype of the chosen solution and tests it with pre-defined user personas & stakeholders to gather feedback and validate the concept.

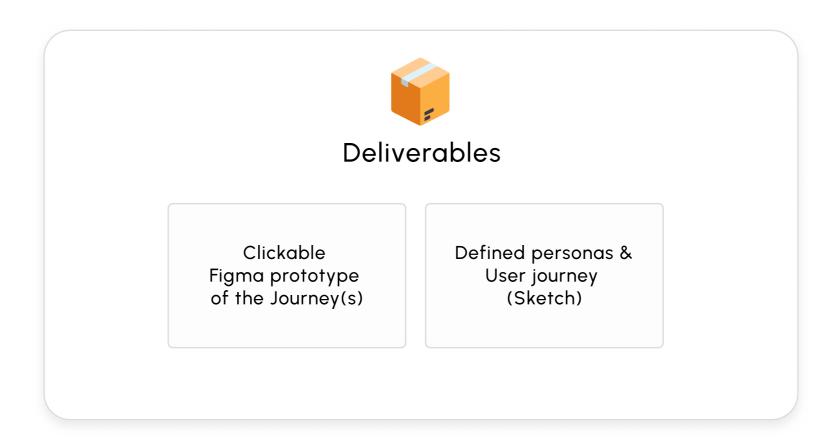
